## Ashbourne Football Club's Codes of Conduct

### Players

On and off the field, I will:

- Adhere to the Laws of the Game
- Display and promote high standards of behaviour
- Promote fair play and behave within the spirit of the Laws of the Game
- Always respect the match officials' decisions
- Never engage in public criticism of the match officials
- Never engage in offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour
- Avoid bullying, intimidation and poor behaviour
- Speak to my team-mates, the opposition and my coach/manager with respect
- Ask my team captain to talk to the referee if I have a problem relating to the game
- Remember we all make mistakes
- Shake hands with the opposing team and the match officials at the end of every game and attend post-match hospitality

I understand that breaches of the code may result in action being taken by my Club, League County FA and The FA.

### Coaches and Team Management

I will:

- Adhere to the Laws of the Game
- Display and promote high standards of behaviour
- Always respect the match officials' decisions
- Never enter the field of play without the referee's permission
- Never engage in public criticism of the match officials
- Never engage in, or tolerate, offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour
- Shake hands with the opposing team managers and the match officials at the end of every game and attend post-match hospitality

When working with players, I will:

- Place the well-being, safety and enjoyment of each player above everything, including winning
- Explain exactly what I expect of players and what they can expect from me
- Ensure the parents/carers of all players under the age of 18 understand these expectations
- Refrain from, and refuse to tolerate any form of bullying
- Develop mutual trust and respect with every player to build their self-esteem
- Encourage each player to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance
- Ensure all activities I organise are appropriate for the players' ability level, experience, age and maturity
- Co-operate fully with others in football (e.g. officials, doctors, physiotherapists, welfare officers) for each player's best interests

I understand that breaches of the code may result in action being taken by my Club, County FA and The FA.

### All Club members

At all times I will:

- Show respect to others involved in the game including match officials, opposition players, coaches, managers, officials, spectators, Club volunteers, members and officers of Club committees
- Demonstrate commitment to the Club and support its development and success
- Promptly pay any membership fees, subscriptions, fines or any other monies due to the Club
- Represent Ashbourne Football Club in a positive way
- Do nothing to bring the Club in to disrepute, adversely affect its activities or create dissent or division
- Abide by the decisions of the Club

I understand that breaches of these codes may result in action being taken by my Club, County FA and The FA.

### **Breaches of Club Rules and Codes of Conduct**

Ashbourne Football Club has the ability to ensure members adhere to these codes of conduct, though serious misconduct at matches will be addressed by the FA or County FA. For those in breach, the Club may take action which could include fines, omission from the team (in respect to players), request for non-attendance at matches or removal from the club membership in severe cases.

Sanctions can be imposed by Team Management, Sub-Committees or the Club Committee. Appeals against sanctions must be lodged in writing within 7 days of the sanction being communicated to the member, and will ultimately be heard by the Club Committee whose decision will be final.
